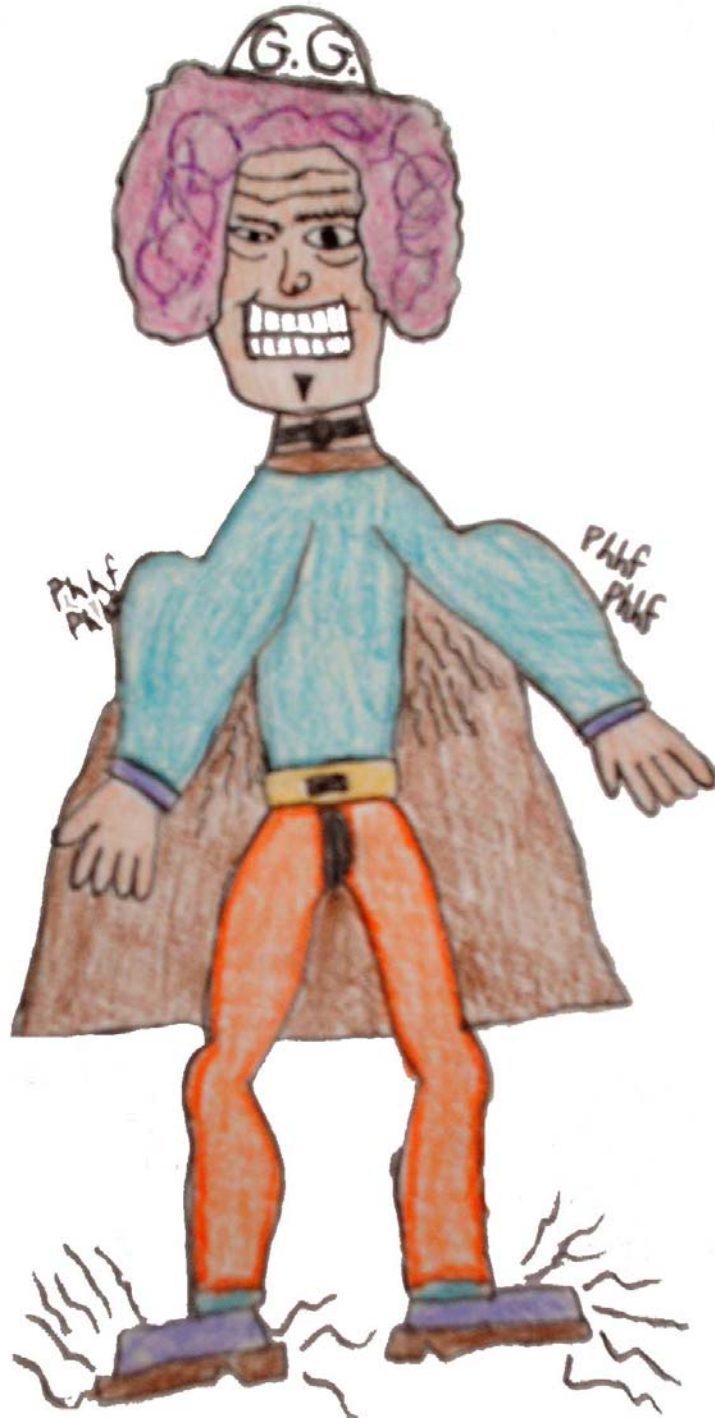


The Great Adventure of Goofy Guy By D.C. Fritz



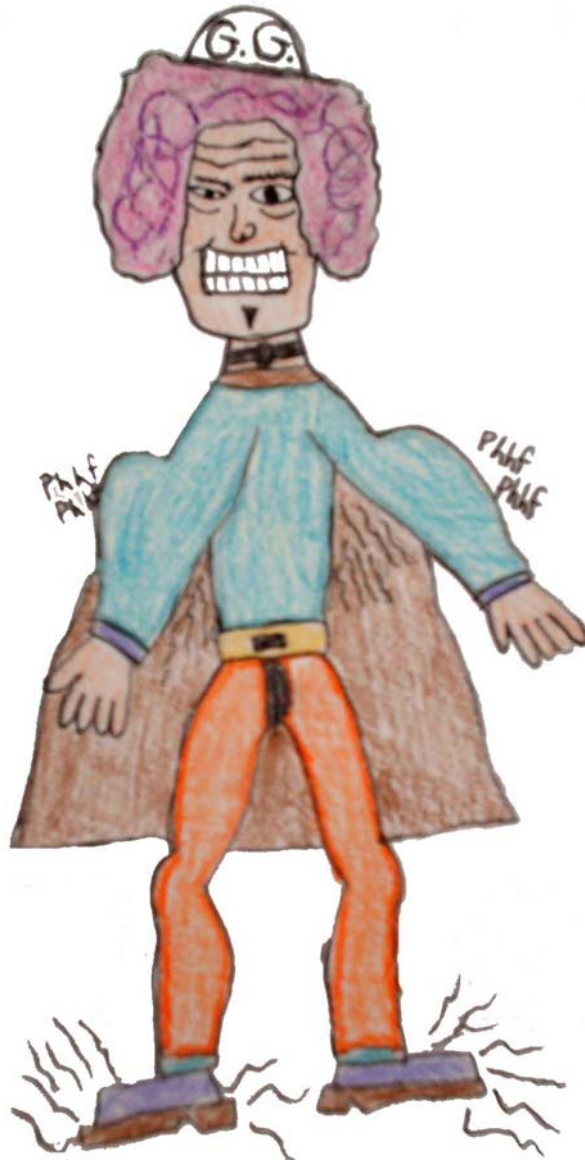
